

APPLYING IN THE PUBLIC COMPETITION

WHO – All Italian and foreign citizens holding an MA degree or equivalent foreign qualification are eligible to apply in the public competition.

HOW – The first step is applying for admission to the public competition online, at <http://milano.unicatt.it/dottorato-bandi>. Applications for admission must be printed, completed with all required documentation, and delivered to (or handed in at) 'Ufficio Dottorati'.

APPLYING FOR ADMISSION IN A NUMBER OF PUBLIC COMPETITIONS – Applicants may apply in one or more competitions. A separate application must be completed online (along with required documentation) for each Doctoral Programme competition in which candidates wish to take part.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION – All applicants must submit: curriculum vitae, achieved qualification/degree certificate or self-certification thereof, copy of an ID document. Applicants are also recommended to verify whether admission to the selected Doctoral Programme requires submission of a research project (information is available in the public competition announcement).

FEES – Admission fees are non-refundable and amount to €100.00 (information on payment terms is available in the online procedure).

ADMISSION TEST

WHERE AND WHEN – Admission tests are held on different dates depending on the Doctoral Programme. The public competition announcement at <http://milano.unicatt.it/dottorato-bandi> provides information on admission test locations and dates.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE – The public competition announcement outlines and governs the procedures for admission to the Doctoral Programmes (written and oral tests, or competition based on qualifications and published work).

WRITTEN TESTS – The topics presented in the admission tests pertain to those tackled in the Doctoral Programmes. Tests of previous years may be consulted at 'Ufficio Dottorati'.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS – Applicants may sit the admission tests upon presentation of an ID document. Use of codes and dictionaries shall be allowed upon the decision of the Admission Board, at the examination premises.

AFTER THE ADMISSION TEST

RANKING – Results of the admission tests will be published at <http://progetti.unicatt.it/progetti-milano-e-piacenza-esiti-prove-concorsuali>

ENROLMENT – Admitted candidates will be notified enrolment instructions via email. Candidates shall enrol through an online procedure and deliver all required documentation to 'Ufficio Dottorati' within 7 working days.
